Occupancy: Set-up will begin at 7:00 am and tear-down will begin at 2:00 pm. The exhibition hours are 9 am – 2 pm. There will be a complimentary vendor networking breakfast hour with refreshments from 7:00 am-8:00 am.

Please read and initial all 3 sections below - Indemnification and Release, Insurance and Force Majeure:

Indemnification and Release: Exhibitor hereby expressly releases Rider Jet Center, and all co-sponsors, and any of their agents, shareholders, representatives, officers, or directors from all liability for any injury, damage, or loss to any person or property that may arise from Exhibitor's occupation of booth space and agrees to pay all defense costs related to any claim against ProJet or co-sponsors.

_____Insurance: Exhibitor shall, at its own cost and expense, obtain all necessary insurance coverage to enable it to meet its obligations associated with exhibiting at trade shows and other events. Note: 1-day waivers are available through most insurance companies.

Our goal is to assist students in the pursuit of their dreams and aviation goals.

Note: To date, we have distributed over \$1.6 Million Dollars in Aviation Scholarships!

Scholarship Sponsorships require a commitment in advance of the event, so we can promote them appropriately. We have 3 types of scholarships we offer. Please select the category that best describes your business or school. The Expo Committee will manage Essay Questions, Registration, Intake, Judges, and Winner Selection. All sponsored scholarships checks will reflect the donor's logo.

Monetary Scholarships - Can be donated by any company and/or vendor. You choose your donation amount. These scholarships can be used at the Aviation School or Flight Training Facility of the student's choice. Donations under \$2K will be combined with other donations to form larger scholarship awards. These donations will be invoiced in advance and must be paid in full no later than September 16th, 2024, to guarantee expedient delivery to the winners. Scholarships will be awarded directly into student's school ID or training account. We do not award students, cash.

College/University Scholarships - School Specific donations can only be used at those institutions providing the funds. They must be paid by the institution directly into the student's ID account once accepted. Your award never leaves the school. You will NOT be invoiced. Sponsoring schools may set terms of eligibility (program-specific, award amount divided over 4 years, incoming freshman only, etc...). SCHOOL SPECIFIC AWARDS ARE FOR NEW INCOMING STUDENTS TO THAT INSTITUTION/TRAINING FACILITY.

Monetary and College-Specific scholarships are based on an essay competition which is designed, implemented, and judged based on criteria set forth by the Expo Scholarship Committee. Sponsors are invited to attend the Expo and participate in presenting their award. The names of the Scholarship Sponsors enjoy inclusion in press releases, promotional posters, programs, and the Expo website. In addition, your logo will appear on your prize check award!

Flight School Scholarships - WILL BE A SEPARATE ESSAY QUESTION: Each flight school donating a scholarship will need to answer the following questions:
