2021 SCHOLARSHIP COMMITMENTS

Note: NEW – Our planning committee has made the decision that ALL scholarship commitments will be honored regardless of the event canceling due to COVID again.

Our goal is to assist students in the pursuit of their dreams and aviation goals. Should the event need to cancel again – we would still award the scholarships on other planned dates, in smaller numbers of attendees and you would be invited to present your awards.

Note: To date, we have awarded over \$2.1 Million Dollars in Aviation Scholarships!

Scholarship Sponsorships require a commitment in advance of the event, so we can promote them appropriately. We have 3 types of scholarships to sponsor. Please check your preference: Flight School Scholarships - WILL BE A SEPARATE ESSAY QUESTION: Why do you want to learn to fly? And how will you use that opportunity to achieve your future goals? Each flight school donating a scholarship should also answer the following questions: Description of your flight training program: Types of Training/Ratings:___ Locations/Airports where you conduct training: Total Expenses to complete Trainig:_ This scholarship may include ground school, SIM time and/or flight training. You must specify the donation and the amount/value. Each scholarship provided for flight training must include a FREE discovery flight that you will bring with you to the event. If the event goes as planned, your top 5 student essays will be asked to visit your booth at the Expo, and you will make your final decision based on a 60-second interview with them. If the event had to cancel due to health concerns, you would be asked to conduct those interviews virtually and select a winner. Monetary Scholarships - Can be donated by any company and/or vendor. You choose your donation amount. These scholarships can be used at the Aviation School or Flight Training Facility of the student's choice. Donations under \$1K will be combined with other donations to form larger scholarships. These donations will be invoiced in advance and must be paid in full no later than September 1, 2021 to guarantee expedient delivery to the winners. Scholarships will be awarded directly into student's school or training account. College/University Scholarships - Specific donations that can only be used at those institutions providing the funds. They must be paid by the institution directly into the student's ID account once accepted. Sponsoring schools may set terms of eligibility (new student, program-specific, award amount divided over 4 years, etc...). Monetary and College-Specific scholarships are based on an essay competition which is designed, implemented, and judged based on criteria set forth by the Expo Scholarship Committee. All scholarships will be awarded to the winning student's school ID account. Sponsors are invited to attend the Expo and participate in presenting their award. The names of the Scholarship Sponsors enjoy inclusion in press releases, promotional posters, programs, and the Expo website. In addition, your logo will appear on your prize check award! YES!
